DURANGO Intern Report

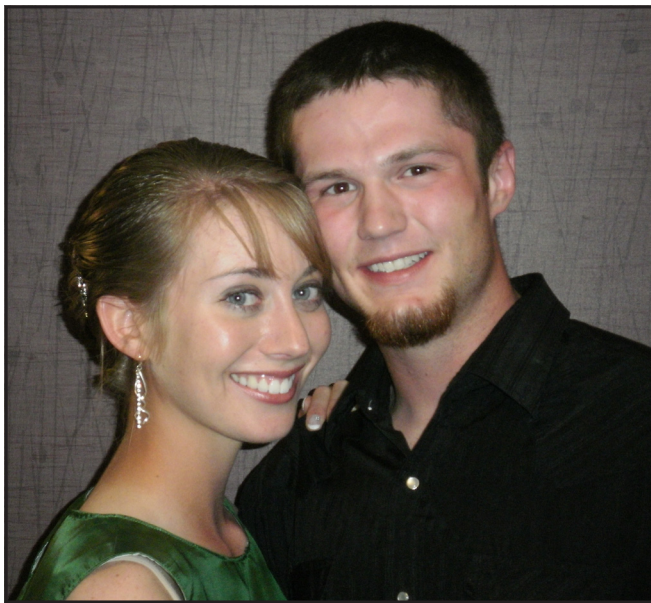

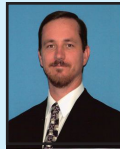
