

# How Jesus “Tasted Death” for Everyone

Hebrews 2:10-18

**INTRODUCTION:** Jesus’ death means much more than a transaction for forgiveness. The perfection of salvation is a process.

## 1. Perfected Through Suffering (v. 10)

a. “Bringing many sons”

b. “Author”

## 2. The High Priest for All Human Beings (vv. 11-17)

a. The Son calls them “brothers” in Scripture

b. The Son shares their human nature

i. To free them from the devil who enslaves by the fear of death

ii. To keep The Promise

iii. To minister forgiveness of sins as the high priest

### 3. Perfectly Qualified Helper (v. 18)

- a. Perfected through the temptation he suffered
  
- b. Help the tempted become perfected through suffering

**CONCLUSION:** Because Jesus “suffered” the human experience—including temptation, Jesus’ “taste” of death applies to every one of God’s “sons.” Jesus’s “brothers” are distinguished by *also suffering* temptation, enabled to do so by the present help of the High Priest, Jesus.
